Q: WHERE IS MONATIONS: THE WORLD TOUR BEING HELD?

A: MONATIONS: The World Tour will be held in 5 locations starting in September and ending in October. The locations are as follows:

Orlando, Florida – 19th September
Anaheim, California – 26th September
Mexico City, Mexico – 10th October
Vienna, Austria – 17th October 2026
Sydney, Australia – October 2026

Q: WHAT IS THE PRICE OF REGISTRATION?

A: The registration cost for MONATIONS: The World Tour per person is:

For Vienna, Austria:

- **48-Hour Offer:** 13th June, 3:30 p.m. BST – 15th June, 10:59 p.m. BST: **€50**
- **Early Bird:** 15th June, 11:00 p.m. BST–12th August, 10:59 p.m. BST: **€65**
- **Standard:** 12th August, 11:00 p.m. BST–event date or sell out: **€75**

o Dream Bigger Celebration (Add-On): **€18**

Q: CAN I ATTEND DIFFERENT LOCATIONS?

A: Yes! You're welcome to attend multiple locations. However, each location requires a separate registration, and the applicable registration fee must be paid for each one.

Q: HOW DO I REGISTER FOR MONATIONS: THE WORLD TOUR?

A: To register, visit [MONATIONS.com](https://monations.com).

Q: WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS TO QUALIFY FOR ON-STAGE RECOGNITION?

A: The recognition qualification period is 1st August 2025–30th June 2026.

To qualify for on-stage recognition, you must be registered for MONATIONS: The World Tour by 31st July 2026.

Q: WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE REGISTRATION FEE?

: Your registration fee includes admission to a general session on Saturday 17th October.

Q: WHO MAY ATTEND MONATIONS: THE WORLD TOUR?

A: To enter all sessions, you must be a paid registrant with event credentials provided at registration onsite. Minimum age requirements by event type are as follows:

- General Sessions on Saturday: 12 years or older by the event date
- Evening Events: 18 years or older by the event date, unless otherwise specified

Q: DOES MY IN-PERSON REGISTRATION INCLUDE HOTEL, AIRFARE, OR MEALS?

A: No. Hotel accommodations, airfare, and meals are not covered by the registration fee.

Q: MAY I BRING MY CHILD?

A: Nursing infants 12 months or younger may attend with their registered parent at no additional cost.

However, nursing mothers and infants may be asked to relocate to the dedicated onsite suite should their infants affect the ability of other attendees to hear the event without disruption.

- Attendees with infants 12 months or younger may consider bringing ear protection due to the volume of the event.
- Attendees must be at least 12 years of age to attend general sessions. Regardless of age, other than nursing infants, all attendees must be registered and display valid event credentials to access sessions.

Q: MAY MY SPOUSE OR GUEST ATTEND?

A: Certainly! Spouses should register separately to receive their own event credentials for access to all sessions. Spouse or guest attendance is not included with Market Partner registration at MONATions: The World Tour. Your Market Partner ID cannot be used to register your spouse or guest.

Q: MAY I REGISTER TO ATTEND THE DREAM BIGGER CELEBRATION ONLY?

A: No. Access to evening events is limited to registered attendees. The Dream Bigger Celebration is available as an add-on and must be selected with the purchase of a registration ticket.

Q: WHAT IS THE SUGGESTED ATTIRE FOR THE EVENT?

A: We recommend business casual attire for the event. Event spaces may be chilly, so plan accordingly. More details on special event attire will be shared closer to event dates.

Q: MAY I REQUEST A REFUND?

A: Yes. The Early Bird and Standard registrations are refundable until 13th August 2026. The 48-Hour Offer registrations are non-refundable.

Q: MAY I CHANGE THE NAME ON MY REGISTRATION?

A: No name changes or transfers are permitted on any registration.

Q: WILL THERE BE TRANSLATIONS AND ASL INTERPRETATION PROVIDED FOR THIS EVENT?

A: Yes. Language translations will be available. Interpretations will vary by event location, and may include Spanish, French, Polish, Lithuanian, German, Italian, and International Sign Language (ISL). MONAT events are fully ADA-compliant. Please indicate any ADA accommodation requests during the registration process.
